

Bosnia Flood Appeal

Tens of thousands have fled their homes, taking refuge in sports halls and schools.

- Situation is critical in Zavidovici, near Maglaj, in Doboij in northern cities of Bosnia along the bank of the Sava River.
- About 1,000 people, including pregnant women, children and the elderly were evacuated from the region of Zeljezno Polje in central Bosnia, where hundreds of homes were destroyed in landslides.
- Southern parts of Bosnia have avoided major flooding while some suburbs of capital Sarajevo have been flooded in recent days

Aid centres have been set up to distribute medicine, food, blankets and clothing. The most needed items are food, baby food, shovels, diapers, candles, clothing, medicine, bottled water and equipment for hygiene.

Almost one-third of Bosnia has been affected.
